

Scholarships Program (Masters) for 2020

Consciousness of its social responsibility, and its keenness to encourage national cadres, and provide opportunities to complete post-university education and obtain a master's degree for outstanding students looking to join the business sector, and pursuant to Article (5) of its law, the Kuwait Chamber of Commerce and Industry offers scholarships for Kuwaiti men and women students from Applicants for this program, for a master's degree in the following areas:

- Business Administration (MBA).
- Entrepreneurship for Small and Medium Enterprises.
- Knowledge Economy.
- Risk Management & Compliance.

This program provides what the Abdulaziz Hamad Al-Saqr Center for Development and Development offers since its establishment to qualify the national youth for self-employment and work in the private sector. It also comes within the framework of the Chamber's efforts to advance its social responsibility, and to confirm the view of the Kuwait Chamber of Commerce and Industry to education as a key input for economic development.

The Chamber is pleased to announce the opening of applications to benefit from the above-mentioned scholarship program

Conditions for accepting applications:

1. The applicant must be a Kuwaiti national.
2. The applicant must obtain a university qualification with a grade of at least very good.
3. The applicant must not be more than 35 years old when applying for the scholarship.
4. The applicant must not have previously or presently received a similar scholarship or scholarship from any other party.
5. Full-time to study at the university's scholarship.
6. The applicant must obtain admission to study for a master's degree from one of the distinguished universities mentioned on the Chamber's website only, provided that admission from the university is final and unconditional acceptance, and the university is accredited by the National Authority for Academic Accreditation and Quality Assurance of Education.
7. That the registered program does not have an Executive Master program.
8. The mission is limited to obtaining a master's degree, and does not extend to any other university degree.
9. Submit the application with all the required documents during the period indicated in the announcement of the mission.
10. It is required that the university accept the same year of the scholarship.
11. The master's program at the university should be in the English language.
12. Candidate students must provide proof of their proficiency in the English language according to the regulations used in each of the accredited universities
13. The major of the applicant for the scholarship in the first university degree must correspond to the major of the masters that the applicant wishes to nominate.

So please prohibit copies of official personal identification documents (civil ID, passport, birth certificate, last university certificate, certificate from the General Insurance Institute, a personal photo, equivalence of certificates issued outside the State of Kuwait)

- Applications are submitted in person to the Abdulaziz Hamad Al-Saqr Center for Development and Development, located in the Kuwait Chamber of Commerce and Industry, accompanied by all the required documents.
- The deadline for accepting applications is before the end of the official working hours on Tuesday, June 9, 2020
- The winners of the grant are chosen by a specialized committee for this task.
